
Social Media Apps 17+





- 'Snap Map' feature allows others to view your exact location.
- Recent update calculates how long it will take to drive to that destination.
- Can be disabled by using 'Ghost Mode' or turning off the location sharing in the phone settings.

What is sextortion?

Sextortion is webcam blackmall.

Criminals can befriend a victim online by using a fake identity and often use a video of an attractive woman to entice the victim to perform sexual acts in front of their webcarn. They then record this and threaten to share the video with the victim's friends and family, unless the victim pays them money.

How to avoid becoming a victim

Be cautious about who you befriend online, even if you have mutual friends.

Avoid getting naked on webcam. There's always a chance this could be recorded and shared.

What to do if you're a victim of sextortion

Don't panic

Contact your local police immediately. No one will judge you, it will be dealt with in confidence, and it will be taken seriously.

Don't communicate further with criminals

Take screenshots, then delete and block offenders. Consider changing your name online so they can no longer locate your profile.

Don't pay Many victims who have paid, have continued to get more demands for higher amounts of money.

Creating a safe space and open environment
















"Show Me, Tell Me, Teach Me"






 Set up privacy controls within the app or game itself.


Advice on how to stay secure online from the UK's National Cyber Security Centre

Your email is where you keep your most personal and financial information.

If a cyber criminal accesses your email, they could:

- access your other online accounts using the 'forgot password' feature (which often sends you an email)
- access personal or business information and use this to scam you or people you know




